Outcome 2 from the EYLF: Children are connected with and contribute to their world and Children become socially responsible and show respect for the environment.

We have started our focus on the rainforest habitat particularly the rainforest of Indonesia where there are many animals becoming endangered due to palm oil plantations. We have begun discussions about animals that live in the rainforest and this year we have sponsored an Elephant called Anna.

Each year we sponsor an animal through a website called Palm Oil Investigations.

It cost approx. \$70 for a one off payment.

We have also set up our own rainforest at Kindy where the children have contributed their ideas about what a rainforest looks like.

Numeracy:

At Preschool we link the Literacy and Numeracy Indicators to the daily learning that occurs at Kindy. Each term we have decided to focus on one indicator. This term we are focussing on: I quantify my world

We are providing experiences to talk about quantities, describing collections, using vocabulary to describe size, length, capacity and names of numbers. Play is the best process to investigate these concepts.

Literacy: I use language to connect with my world

Our Literacy focus this term is : I use language to connect with my world..

We are encouraging your child to communicate and express their ideas through conversations, discussions, asking questions and listening. We have set up shared play experiences, story tables and small story groups to encourage wonder and interest in their environment.

If you ask your child "what did you do at Kindy today? and they say "Nothing" or "I don't remember!! Please take some time at the beginning or the end of the day to look at our book near the sign on sheet which shows what we have been doing at Kindy.
